





Application Staggered Dates

NAIT will continue to use the following application opening dates for applicants applying to begin studies in the 2024-2025 academic year:

- Fall 2024 term: applications will open October 1
- Winter 2025 term: applications will open March 1
- Spring 2025 term: applications will open June 1

Change in Entrance Requirements

NAIT has undertaken an extensive review of entrance requirements for 2024-25, so you may notice that requirements for a number of programs have changed. This review was intended to reduce the complexity in our entrance requirements, while still maintaining the standards for admission that programs require.

We are now also describing our entrance requirements a little differently – we're listing the grade level of a required course first, followed by the minimum Alberta Ed course that would satisfy the entrance requirement. For example:

- The old way would have been to list a Math requirement like this: Math 30-1 or Math 30-2
- The new way is to say: Grade 12 Mathematics (Math 30-2)

We will, of course, continue to accept higher-level or equivalent courses to that minimum course that's listed. This change to how we describe our entrance requirements is intended to be a little more friendly to our applicants from other provinces or countries who may not be as familiar with Alberta Ed courses.






